

HIGHWAYS AGENCY**THE A20 TRUNK ROAD – SWANLEY INTERCHANGE
TEMPORARY OVERNIGHT SLIP ROAD CLOSURE**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Secretary of State for Transport intends to make an Order on the A20 Trunk Road, in the County of Kent, under section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because works are proposed to be executed on the road.

The effect of the Order would be to authorise the overnight closure of the slip road leading from the eastbound carriageway of the A20 to the roundabout at Swanley Interchange (M25 Junction 3/M20 Junction 1). This would be in the interests of road safety while contractors undertake resurfacing and road marking work.

It is expected that the work would last for approximately 1 week starting on or after Monday 19th July 2010 at the following times:

Monday – Thursday nights	2200-0530 hours
Friday night	2300-0600 hours
Saturday night	2200-0600 hours
Sunday night	2230-0530 hours

The Order would come into force on 17th July 2010 and have a maximum duration of eighteen months.

During the closure outlined above, traffic affected would be diverted at Crittall's Corner (A223/A224), northeast on the A223 (Edgington Way/North Cray Road) to the roundabout at its junction with the A2018, east on the A2018 (Vicarage Road/Dartford Road/Old Bexley Lane/Shepherds Lane) to its junction with the B2174, east on the B2174 (Princes Road) to its junction with the A225/A226, traffic may either continue south on the A225 (Hawley Road/Main Road/Dartford Road) to the roundabout at its junction with the A20 at Farningham, and west on the A20 (London Road) to the roundabout at Swanley Interchange (M25 Junction 3/M20 Junction 1); or east on the A225 (Princes Road) to the roundabout at its junction with the B260/A296, southeast on the B260 (Trolling Down Hill/Green Street Green Road) to Lane End, west on Darenth Hill/Parsonage Lane and south on the A225 (Main Road) to join the main diversion route.

The slip road closure and diversion route would be clearly indicated by traffic signs when it is in operation during the works periods.
