

**The Town and Country Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) (England and Wales) Regulations 1999 (as amended)  
Publicity of Submission of Environmental Statement  
Proposed development at Gravesend Heritage Quarter.**

Edinburgh House Estates Limited, the applicant, gives notice that it has submitted further amendments to planning application reference 2008/0696 relating to the Gravesend Heritage Quarter on 16 July 2010 to Gravesham Borough Council, Civic Centre, Windmill Street, Gravesend, Kent DA12 1AU.

The submission includes a package of revised plans, covering letter, further illustrative material, and an updated Environmental Statement Addendum. The following description of development has not changed:

*“The demolition of buildings and redevelopment of land in Gravesend Town Centre (known as the Heritage Quarter) for a mix of uses including retail and food and drink (A1/A2/A3/A4/A5), offices (B1), hotel (C1), residential (C3), church hall (D1), car parking and amenity space, with associated servicing, landscaping and highway works. Detailed consent is sought for the Eastern Quarter and outline consent (including details of access only with all other matters reserved) is sought for the Western Quarter.”*

A copy of the amended submission, including plans and other documents submitted with it, together with a copy of the updated environmental statement may be inspected by members of the public at all reasonable hours at the Civic Centre, Windmill Street, Gravesend, Kent DA12 1AU until 12 August 2010.

Members of the public may obtain copies of the Addendum to the Environmental Statement from the Civic Centre, Windmill Street, Gravesend, Kent, DA12 1AU so long as stocks last, at a charge of £45 + VAT (paper copy) and £10 + VAT (CD copy).
